Good old fashioned down home cooking by a family that has been doing it for 6 generations!



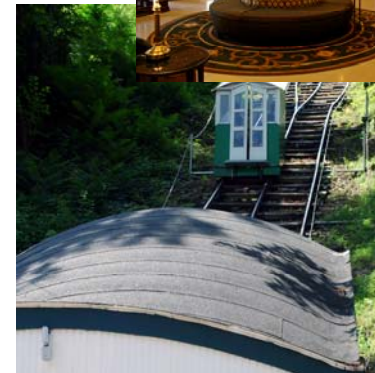
Day Three
