Dubuque Arboretum & Botanical Gardens

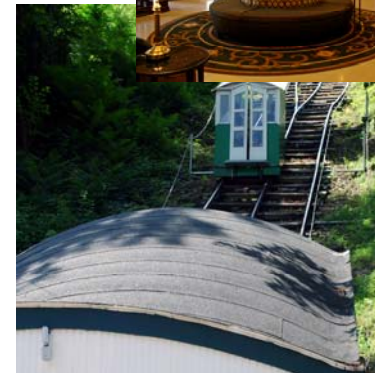
